- ✓ Matthew Barnes appointed BT Board Anti-Doping Member and Tom Stammer appointed BT Anti-Doping Lead
- ✓ Work has followed between BT CEO, Membership Services, Safeguarding, Marketing and Development to upload to the UKAD Assurance Portal either-
 - Existing BT information as evidence
 - o Amended and approved existing BT Policies & Procedures
 - New and approved BT Policies & Procedures
- ✓ BT are currently 78% compliant with the following key omissions
 - o Proof of a BT Board Resolution to fully adopt UKAD Rules
 - o An Annual Report of activities to the BT Members (planned for Dec 2022)
- ✓ BT now have 2 new documents to approve-
 - BT Anti-Doping Education Strategy
 - o BT Anti-Doping Education Implementation Plan
- ✓ All BT Coaches and Senior G Ranking BT Competitors (excl. GBT) have received information on the WADA List of Prohibited Substances and the need for TUE's
- ✓ Marketing have issued several BT Website News and social media items focusing on our commitment to Clean Sport and to UKAD Rules
