

Role: Computer Operator

Reporting To: Head of Court / Scoring System Technician

Role Purpose

The Computer Operator is responsible for managing the scoring and timing software during the competition. This role is critical to ensuring accurate and timely recording of results and smooth operation of each ring.

Key Responsibilities

- Operate the scoring and timing software for the assigned ring.
- Ensure the correct match data is loaded and updated in real-time.
- Monitor and record scores, penalties, and match outcomes accurately.
- Coordinate with the Ring Supervisor and Judges to confirm results.
- Report any technical issues to the Head of Court and Court Supervisor promptly.

Shift Details

- Morning (0800-1400) and afternoon (1330-1830) shifts available.
- Please arrive at least 30 minutes before your shift for briefing and setup.

What to Wear

- Comfortable, plain clothing (preferably black or navy).
- Flat, closed-toe shoes suitable for walking/standing.
- Volunteer T-shirt (provided on the day).
- Accreditation badge (must be worn at all times).

Skills and Experience

- Basic computer literacy and confidence using software.
- Attention to detail and accuracy under pressure.
- Good communication and teamwork skills.
- Calm and focused in a fast-paced environment.
- Familiarity with Poomsae scoring, and knowledge of Poomsae competition rules is a plus but not essential (full system training provided on the day).
