The likes of Louis Exton, Adrianna Beard and Summer Waheed contributed towards history being made as Great

Britain claimed a record 19 medals across all events, as well as winning the European Para Poomsae Team Trophy for the first time in Estonia.

Beyond medals and podium finishes, the wider British Taekwondo community prides itself on being welcoming, supportive, and inclusive. Across more than 500 affiliated clubs nationwide, coaches, volunteers, officials, and members work tirelessly to create environments where people feel safe, valued, and empowered to reach their potential. We also recognise the importance of continuing to evolve as an organisation and as a sport.
